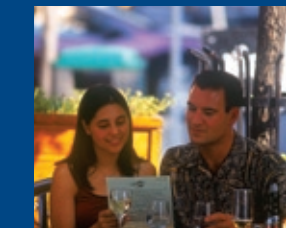

Ca Health Sciences Centre (HSC)* **Ch** **Cc** **Cs** **Er** **Me** **Mh** **On** **Rg** **Rh** **Su** **Wh**

Located on 32 acres of land in central Winnipeg, HSC is Manitoba's premier hospital for teaching, research and patient care. HSC is one of the largest facilities of its kind in Canada, and a major referral centre for complex health problems requiring expert consultation and sophisticated investigation and management. Designated as the Trauma Centre for Manitoba, HSC is also the centre for transplants and for most hospital-based pediatric care in the province. It offers a full range of health care services through inpatient units and ambulatory care programs in medicine, surgery, child health, women's health, mental health, oncology, critical care, renal, and rehabilitation.

HSC's new critical services building provides patients and staff with state-of-the-art operating rooms, intensive care and emergency areas. HSC is affiliated with the University of Manitoba's teaching programs in nursing, medicine and a variety of other professional disciplines. HSC serves not only the people of Manitoba, but also its neighbours in Northwestern Ontario and Nunavut. It also plays a unique role in the provision of health care to the Aboriginal population of Manitoba.

Located in the heart of the French speaking community, SBGH serves more than 208,000 patients annually from across Manitoba, Northwestern Ontario and parts of Saskatchewan. The second largest hospital in Manitoba, SBGH provides an extensive range of inpatient, outpatient and ambulatory care services in emergency, medicine, surgery, woman and child and mental health. Its resources include some of the most advanced medical and diagnostic equipment available.

SBGH is the centre of excellence for cardiac care in Manitoba, and is a recognized leader in many disciplines including geriatrics, perinatal care, gastrointestinal diseases and family medicine. SBGH supports advanced medical and nursing research through its Research Centre, MRI Facility and the Clinical Research Institute.

SBGH is affiliated with the University of Manitoba's faculties of medicine, nursing and various allied health disciplines.

Community hospitals



Cc Concordia Hospital **Cs** **Fm** **On** **Ph** **Rg** **Su**

Concordia Hospital has been providing quality patient care for over 75 years. Its roots began in a house on Machray Avenue serving as a maternity hospital with five beds and three staff.

Today, Concordia Hospital is located on Concordia Avenue just west of Lagimodiere Boulevard. Concordia provides surgical, medicine, emergency/critical care, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, laboratory, diagnostic imaging, and other allied health and long term care services. The pharmacy provides decentralized clinical services and is supported by an automated unit dose drug distribution system.

Together with the WRHA, Concordia has developed a centre of excellence in lower extremity arthroplasty. Two new state-of-the-art operating rooms have been built, and a comprehensive patient follow-up service has been created that includes medical teaching and research. Concordia is the first community hospital in Canada with a designated medical teaching program.

Located near the rolling banks of Sturgeon Creek, Grace Hospital is a community hospital that provides quality patient-centred care in an environment that reflects Christian values. With roots now more than 100 years old in Winnipeg, the Grace remains committed to continued growth to meet the changing needs of the community.

Grace Hospital provides surgical, medical, mental health, and emergency programs as well as physiotherapy, occupational therapy, pharmaceutical, laboratory and diagnostic imaging services. The Grace has been a centre for orthopedic surgery in Manitoba for some time. Close to 1,000 total joint replacement procedures are performed at the hospital annually.

As well, a new 12-bed hospice provides care for palliative care patients.

Cc Seven Oaks General Hospital (SOGH) **Er** **Fm** **Mh** **On** **Rg** **Rh** **Su**

Established in 1981, SOGH serves northwest Winnipeg, the area immediately north of the city, and Manitoba's Interlake region. As a fully accredited acute health care facility, SOGH has established its leadership role through initiatives such as program management, the Caremap® System and geriatric day hospital.

SOGH's unique approach to patient care is reflected in the design of its building, which has been specifically configured to make patient care easier to provide. Inpatient units are arranged in groupings of patient rooms surrounding a nursing station. All rooms are within sight and a few steps of the nursing station. Each grouping or cluster accommodates 10 patients, and is under the direction of a registered nurse.

SOGH is also home to the first medical fitness facility of its kind in Canada – the Seven Oaks Wellness Institute. This facility is part of the hospital, and is dedicated to help individuals achieve and maintain wellness. The facility offers many services including: extensive health education programs, fitness programs, an indoor track, and indoor recreation activity spaces. All services at the facility are available to staff for a discounted fee.

Mh Deer Lodge Centre (DLC) **Ph** **Rg**

As the province's largest rehabilitation and long term care facility, Deer Lodge Centre provides many opportunities for challenging experiences and career growth. Conveniently located on Portage Avenue, only a short walk from Assiniboine Park, DLC inpatient and outpatient programming includes rehabilitation, respiratory, mental health, chronic and personal care. As well, we maintain a proud tradition of serving veterans and the military through inpatient and outpatient programs. New services operated at DLC are an Operational Stress Injuries Clinic and Movement Disorders Clinic. As an operating division of the Winnipeg Regional Health Authority, Deer Lodge Centre serves as a centre of excellence in rehabilitation and long term care for the region and provides many regional support services.

The Centre's motto of "Making Lives Better" applies to staff as well as patients and residents. Broad educational offerings, an internationally recognized library, on-site fitness facilities, and access to research help to support staff in their career and personal lives.

Located in a beautiful urban park setting, RHC is recognized as a modern and innovative rehabilitation and long term care facility. The Centre provides a variety of in-patient programs including:

- Rehabilitation for patients with respiratory, acquired brain injury, stroke/ neuromuscular, orthopedic and other diagnoses
- Palliative care
- Complex continuing care for chronically ill and/or ventilator dependent patients
- Residential care for persons with dementia, challenging behaviours and/or with multiple personal care needs

Outpatient services include a Geriatric Day Hospital, a variety of clinics including continence promotion, and adult day programs designed to meet the socialization and recreation needs of isolated elders living in the community.

Ph Winnipeg personal care homes provide care services to people who can no longer manage to live independently in their home, even with family support and/or formal community services, such as home care. Winnipeg's personal care homes are designed to care for people in the most home-like environment possible, given their lifestyles and health care needs.

Personal Care Homes offer the following:

- 24-hour nursing care
- Personal care
- Physician services
- Basic medical supplies
- Food and nutrition
- Medications and pharmacy services
- Group dining, activities and recreation
- Access to occupational therapists, physiotherapists and speech-language pathologists
- Social work and spiritual care
- Housekeeping
- Laundry/linen
- Transportation
- Hairdressing, foot care and dental care are offered on a fee-for-service basis
